DESCRIPTION

Pair of M352 "Lyre" chairs designed in 1968 by Swiss designer Theo Häberli. The molded and perforated plywood shell, lacquered in white, creates a tall and graphic silhouette that reflects Häberli's formal explorations in the late 1960s.

Each chair stands on a central four leg chromed steel base, offering both stability and visual lightness. The combination of industrial materials and refined plywood molding techniques is emblematic of European design from

this era.
