Saburo Inui, a leading figure in Japanese design, reshaped furniture history by blending traditional craftsmanship with modern innovation. As the technical director of Tendo Mokko, Inui played a pivotal role in the company's growth, renowned for its bentwood creations and minimalist, yet functional designs.

Crafted from rosewood and teck wood, this coffee table is distinguished by its organic, curved form. The thick,
