Description

Worked in coloured wools with silk highlights and beads on linen, bearing the initials 'W. B.' and date 1845 (?), the ship depicted off a coast with a row of cottages, a church and a castle flying the Union Flag. The long pennant streaming out behind signifies the vessel is returning home. In a simulated tortoiseshell painted frame
